

# What is NAESC?

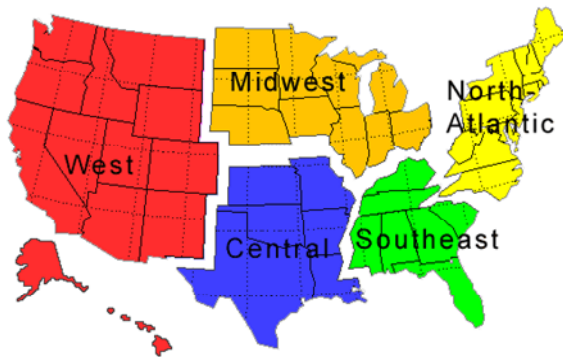
The National Association of Engineering Student Councils, Inc. (NAESC) is a not-for-profit educational organization dedicated to the continual improvement of the engineering educational experience and of the member councils which serve engineering students.

## Purpose

NAESC is here to serve engineering student councils by facilitating communication among member councils, organizing programs and events, providing a resource for information about engineering student activities, and serving as a collective voice for these councils.

## Membership

Membership in NAESC is open to any group of students that strive to advise, govern, and/or represent all engineering students at its ABET accredited institution. The membership of NAESC is divided into six geographical regions.



## Structure

The NAESC Executive Board consists of a President, the Regional Presidents, five vice

presidents: Administration, Communications, Finance, Relations, Outreach, and the National Conference Director. Each of these officers is elected at the National Conference.

The member councils in each region elect a Regional President to sit on the Executive Board. This Regional President serves as a leader for regional activities and recruitment as well as providing a link from the region to the national organization.
